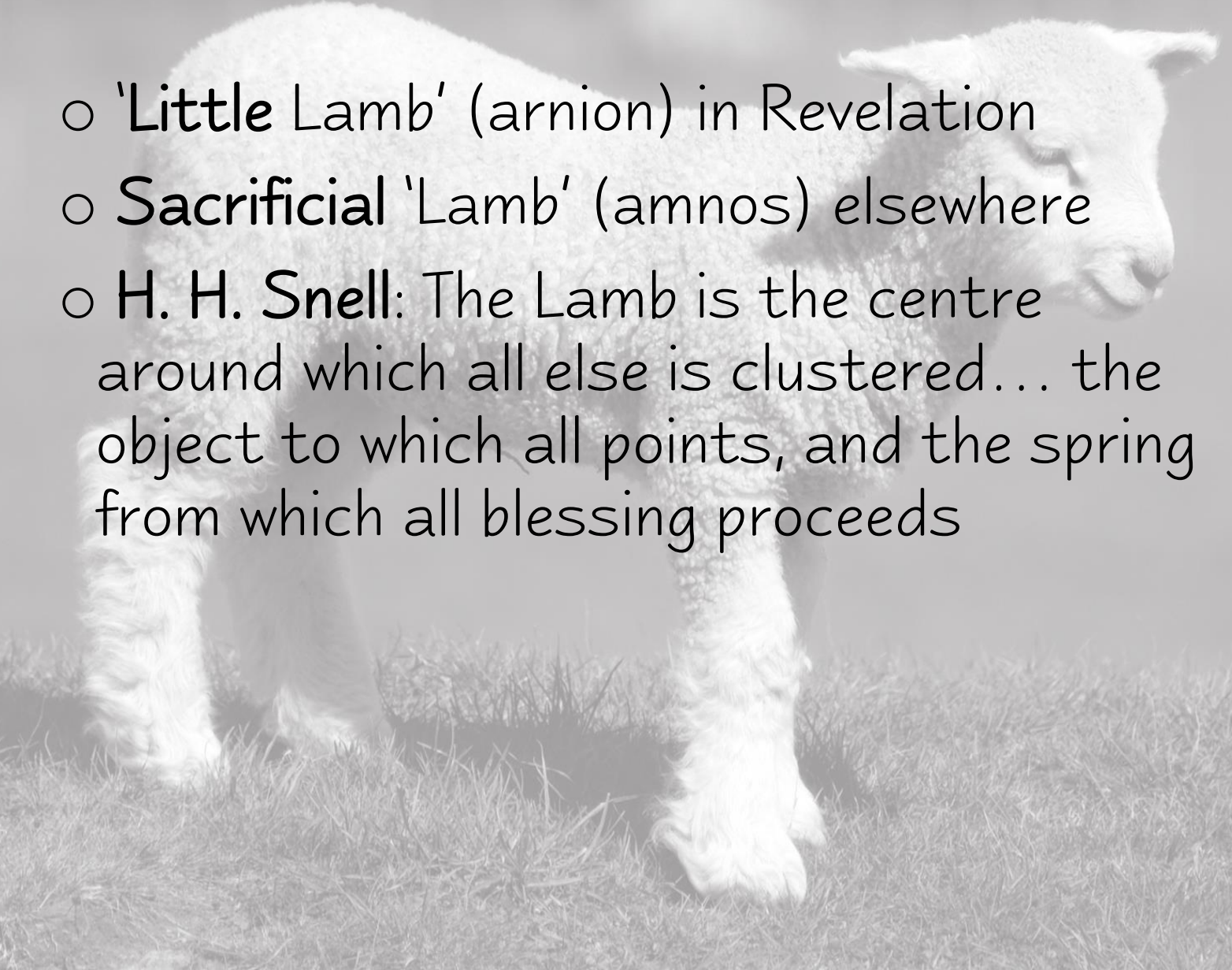

# Perplexity of the Study

- Who is the **mighty angel** in Rev. 10?
- **Weigh up** the arguments!
- **Rev. 5.2:** I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice...
- **Rev. 18.21:** And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea...

# The Lamb

- 'Little Lamb' (arnion) in Revelation
- Sacrificial 'Lamb' (amnos) elsewhere
- H. H. Snell: The Lamb is the centre around which all else is clustered... the object to which all points, and the spring from which all blessing proceeds



# The Amen

- Rev. 3.14: These things saith the Amen
- Dependable, certain, true, fixed
- 'Let it be so' and 'It shall be so'
- 2 Cor. 1.20: All the promises of God in Him are yea, and in Him, amen

# The Beginning of the Creation

- Rev. 3.14: These things saith... the beginning of the creation of God
- Source or origin, beginner or cause
- 2 Cor. 5.17: So if anyone be in Christ, there is a new creation; the old things have passed away; behold all things have become new



# Alpha and Omega

- Rev. 22.13: I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last
- First and last letters of the Greek alphabet
- 'Beginning and ending' = first cause and destiny
- 'First and last' = in time. He was before creation and will remain after it

# Bright and Morning Star

- Rev. 22.16: I am... the bright and morning star
- Lampros = brilliant, shining, glistening
- Morning = relating to the dawn
- **Jim Allen:** The morning star anticipates and heralds the dawning of day
- Rev. 1.28: I will give him (overcomer at Thyatira) the morning star
