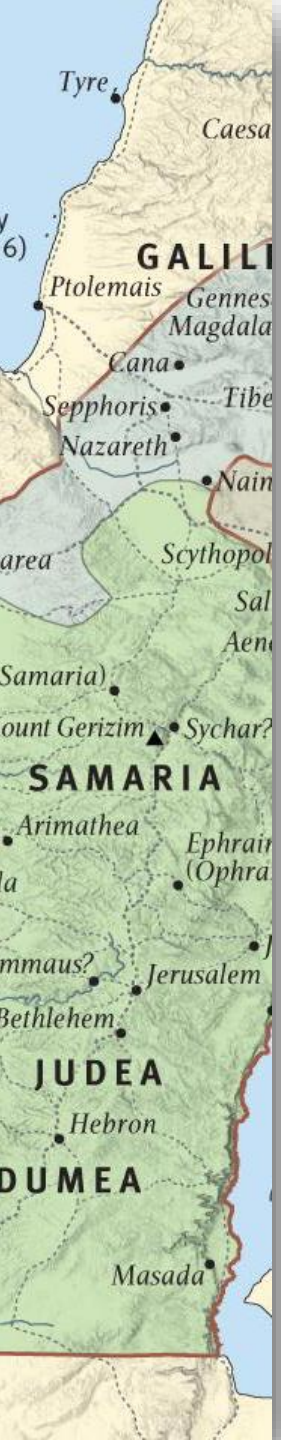

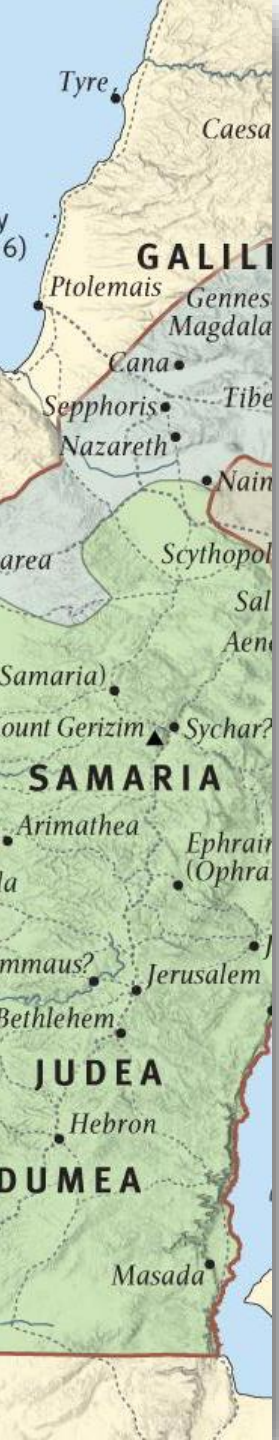
THE AUDIENCE OF THE BOOK

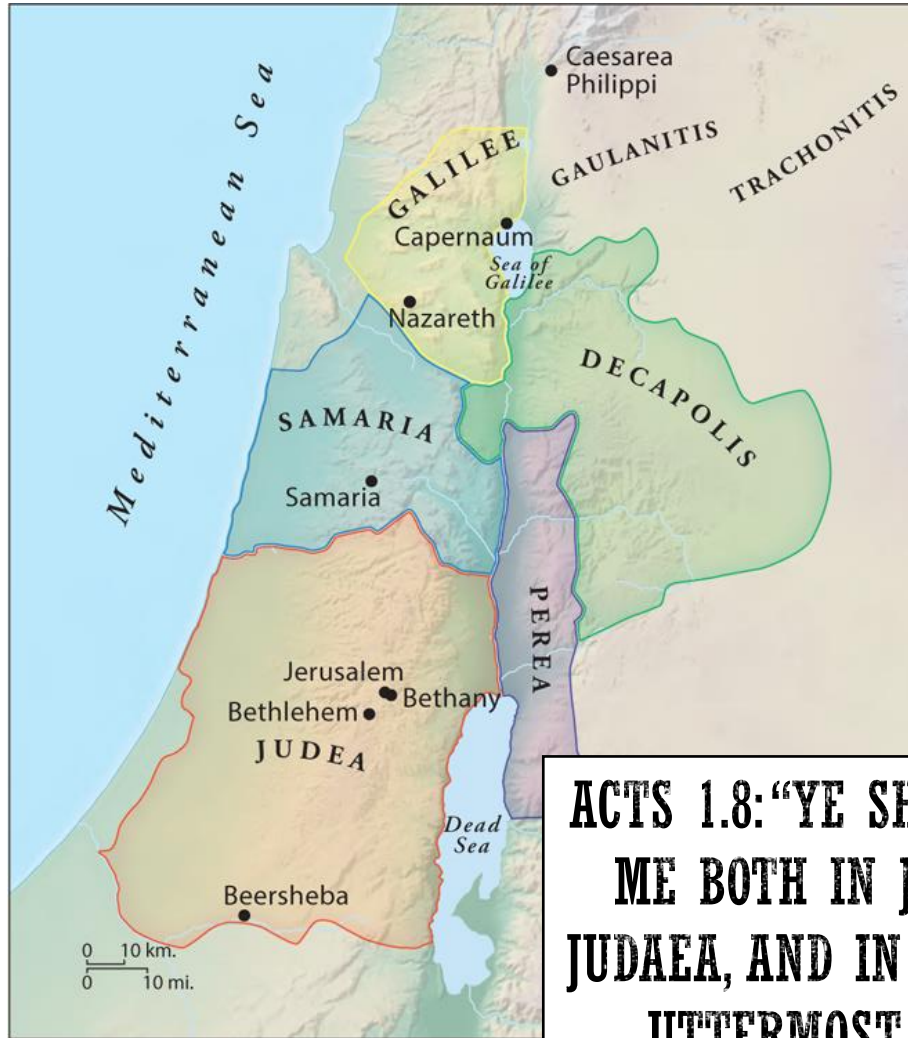

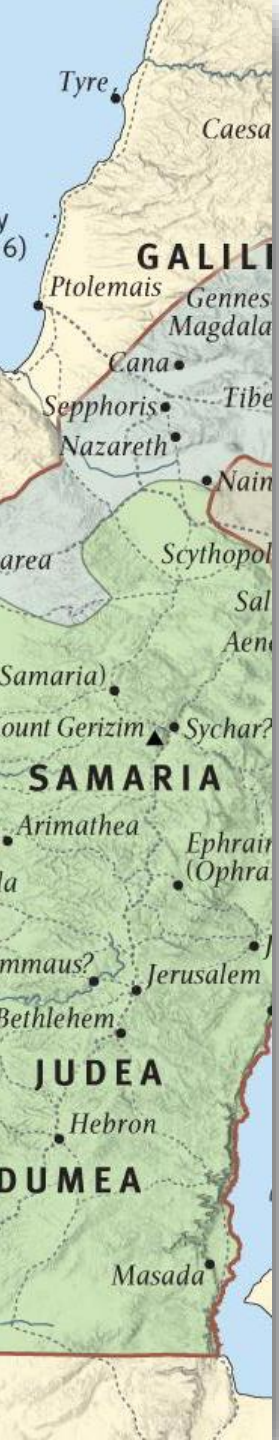

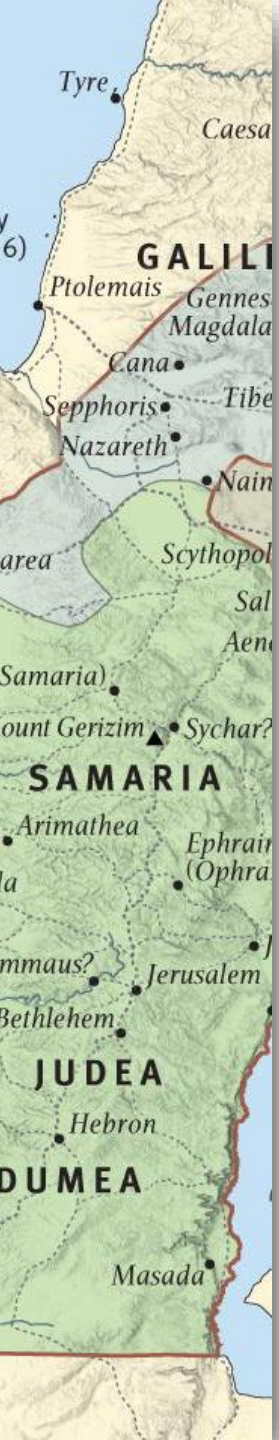
